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## Databases & E-newsletters

### Overview

This week I'd like to introduce the importance of a database and e-newsletters to your business. Social media is fantastic, much of it's free...but none of the data there truly belongs to you or your business. What if Facebook shut down tomorrow? Do you have any record of or regular contact with your likers outside of Facebook? The same applies to your followers or connections on your Twitter, YouTube, LinkedIn or other social media accounts. One of the most valuable assets a business can have is a current database. You can then use this understand more about your current and potential customers, have regular interaction and build a relationship with them – often meaning building trust, understanding and conversion to sales. This lesson focuses on various ways you can manage this via databases and e-newsletters.

### Objectives

- Understand the value of a database and e-newsletters to you & your business
- Review your current database and e-newsletter systems (and start new ones if you choose to)
- Explore other options for a database and e-newsletter if necessary
- Learn to find help when you need it

### Activities

- Is the data I am collecting secure and do I comply with the privacy act?
- Are there other businesses I could approach for cross-promotion in each other's e-newsletters?
- Should I do my own e-newsletters and database entry or could I outsource this?
